



APPLYING TO THE MU INTERDISCIPLINARY NEUROSCIENCE PROGRAM (INP)

Applications and supporting material should be submitted through the MU Graduate School's online [application system](#). Please refer to the following web site for instructions and requirements:

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE REQUIRED

1. Graduate School Application for Admission: Create an application account at [here](#). All other application materials should be included as part of the online application.
2. INP Application Form: Download the "Application Form" from the INP web site: <http://neuroscience.missouri.edu/admission/>. Complete and save the form, then upload the form to the Supplemental Information page of the online application.
3. Transcripts: Applicants are required to upload unofficial copies of all transcripts to the Educational History page of their application. Official copies of transcripts will only be required if an applicant is accepted into the program.
4. GRE's and TOEFL scores: To expedite the review of the application, upload TOEFL or IELTS scores (if applicable) and GRE scores to the Test Information page of their application. Official test scores should be sent to the MU Graduate School (ETS School Code 6875).
5. Recommendations: Three recommendations are required. Applicants should enter recommenders' information in the Recommendation section of the online application. Each recommender will receive an email directing them to a secure site where they will complete the online recommendation.
